

Pickaway County Local Work Group
Priority Practices for Pickaway County

January 12, 2006

The Pickaway SWCD organized a LWG and a stakeholders group previously, held meetings and originally decided the following for Pickaway County.

- 1) The natural resource areas priority rating is soils 1st, water 2nd, plants 3rd, animals 4th and air 5th.
- 2) There should not be any priority area or areas in Pickaway County.
- 3) The priority practices for the various natural resources will be:

A) For Soils:

- 1st – **329A** – Strip Till
- 2nd – **410** – Grade Stabilization Structures, and **412** – Grassed Waterways
- 3rd – **356** – Dike
- 4th – **757i** – Heavy Use Area Protection

B) For Water:

- 1st – **329A** – Strip Till
- 2nd – **580** – Streambank & Shoreline Protection
- 3rd – **702i** – Agrichemical Handling Facility
- 4th – **590** – Nutrient Management and **595** – Pest Management
- 5th – **391** – Riparian Buffer
- 6th – **356** – Dike

C) For Air:

- 1st – **317** – Composting Facility

D) For Plants:

- 1st – **512** – Pasture and Hay Planting
- 2nd – **314** – Brush Management
- 3rd – **666** – Forest Stand Improvement

E) For Animals:

- 1st – **378** – Pond, **516** – Pipeline, **574** – Spring Development, **614** – Trough and **642** – Well - **614** - Watering Facility
- 2nd – **528A** – Prescribed Grazing
- 3rd – **590** – Nutrient Management and **595** – Pest Management
- 4th – **757i** – Heavy Use Area Protection
